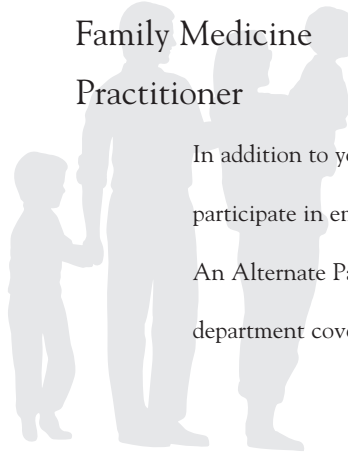

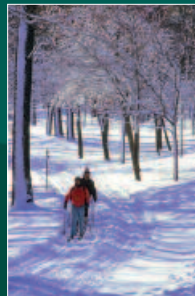


outdoor activities such as cross-country and downhill skiing, mountain biking, canoeing, birding, hiking the Bruce Trail, and rock climbing.
